





Nowadays, already 71% of all jobs require some level of digital skills. In the near future, 90% of the jobs will require digital skills, at least on an elementary level. Completely new jobs will be created in areas that nobody knows today. The labour market will change rapidly in the coming years. Meanwhile, about half of the entire European population aged between 16 and 74 do not have basic digital skills.
